- Checking, cleaning, and filling water troughs
- Weighing and body scoring
- Paddock and shelter cleaning and maintenance
- Assisting with alpaca experiences and visitors
- Assisting with any medical and health needs of individual alpacas.

If, like me, you find being with alpacas is a such a fantastic experience and you are keen to learn more about alpacas, you may also have the opportunity to learn about.

- Handling alpacas
- Parasite control including microscope and diagnosing internal parasites
- Pasture management
- Toenail trimming
